#### Miniature instructions

#### What you'll need:

- 1. Cardstock
- 2. Scissors
- 3. Print out below
- 4. Glue

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Print the printout onto some card stock.
- 2. Cut out the solid line of the printout.
- 3. Place glue all over the back of the printout.
- 4. Fold the dotted lines under each photo towards the photo so they make a right angle.
- 5. Fold the small dotted line between the photos in half so that the backs of the photos are together.
- 6. Fold the small dotted line at the bottom of the Mary Read box back so that it runs along the two other folded tabs, creating a stand for the bottom of the miniature.
- 7. Wait for the glue to dry and you now have a miniature!



- 4. Glue


#### **Instructions:**

  - a. Images




